**Deadlines**

**ASAP** Mail or fax forms from Acceptance Packet: **Settle-Up** (white), **Personality Profile** (blue), **Camper Code of Conduct** (pink) **Health History** (ivory) and **Physician’s Exam** (white) to arrive at least one week prior to session.  
 ► **Camper will be restricted from all physical activities until completed Health History (with health insurance) and Physician’s Exam are on file with Registrar.**

**1 Month Prior** Mail balance of tuition, unless credit card authorization has been provided.  
 If Registrar has to call for this payment, a \$10 fee will be imposed. Returned check fee, \$35.

**Visitation** If you drive to YSSC to pick-up/drop-off your child, it’s a great opportunity to tour camp and meet the staff. We do not schedule visitation during the session to prevent homesickness in your child, as well as to protect the feelings of other campers.

**Canteen** Campers have an account at the Canteen camp store and have no need to carry money at camp. Items including toothpaste, disposable cameras, stamps, souvenirs and healthy treats are available. On certain excursions, campers will draw on their account for snacks.

**Identification of Clothing and Equipment**

1

**Luggage** Tag or mark clearly on the outside of each piece of luggage, sleeping bag and pillow with Camper's name. Camper's have a large drawer to store all of their belongings.

**Clothing** Mark each item taken to camp, including the clothing worn to camp, with full name. The easiest method is using a waterproof marking pen. Or, you may attach waterproof name tags.

**Personal Items** Mark shoes, toiletries, camera, Bible, etc., with permanent marker.

**“Contraband”** If brought to camp, camper must turn in contraband which will be held in safe keeping and returned to Camper on Closing Day.

**Lost and Found** The camp will not be responsible for the loss of personal articles. Camper is requested to not bring any items of special value to camp.
